

#### Tully Fish Kill Update

**11.23.08** - From all reports this was a relatively minor fish kill. Depending anywhere from a dozen to two hundred trout were killed. It is believed that while Bass and a few chubs all the fish killed were part of the October 23rd stocking. Mike Kaufmann, believes the cause may be Heron predation due to the low water concentration of fish. The bottom line is that we will probably never know the have involved any holdover fish.

**11.19.08** - A Fish kill in the Tulpehocken Creek is the focus of a state investigation. Friday that they are investigating what caused dozens of fish to die this week just below the dam at Blue Marsh Lake. The fish kill was first reported by fishermen


